EASE OF TRAVEL

Citizens of almost all countries in the world can obtain a visa on arrival.

SUITABLE CLIMATE

Majestic mountains surround Dhulikhel and Kathmandu, the locations of the University's main and satellite campuses. The four distinct seasons bring freshness throughout the year and invite with them the myriad festivals Dhulikhel and Kathmandu Valley Civilization are known for.

GLOBAL COMPETENCE

- (a) English Medium Teaching: KU offers all courses, except a few language courses such as Nepali, Japanese and Chinese, in English. Most of the universities worldwide recognise and accept KU students without standardised tests.
- **(b)** Easy Credit Transfer: KU accepts credits earned from other universities; counterpart universities also recognise KU's credit without any hassle.
- (c) Global Exchange/Internships: Over 60 KU students take up exchange opportunities every year through Erasmus Mundus and other programmes. Following on a successful track record of joint degree programmes, KU has signed up for more such programmes, including with Hebei University of Economics and Business, China; Western Sydney University (WSU); and IITs (Indian Institutes of Technology). As KU is collaborating with over 274 universities and higher education institutions from over 41 countries, students get internship opportunities at those prestigious institutions.
- (d) Friendly Environment for International Students: Almost 12.33 percent of the total KU graduates (5,225 out of 43,134) are foreign nationals from 55 countries. KU reserves 10 percent seats for international students in each of its programmes.

MODEST FEE STRUCTURE AND AFFORDABLE LIVING COSTS

KU offers affordable education, some of the two-year MA programmes in Social Sciences costing only US \$1,000 per semester for international students. In addition, the affordable living costs make Nepal a go-to destination for higher education.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FELLOWSHIPS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- (a) Research students get the opportunity to work as Research Fellows. At least one Research Fellow (RF) is assigned to each Professor and Associate Professor, and international students working as RF get benefits such as fee waiver and local accommodation.
- (b) Scholarships for international students (one scholarship each in all seven schools) on the recommendation of respective Embassies/Government of Nepal.
- (c) Fee waivers available (up to 50 percent) for needy international students.
